Pastor Kevin's Reflections

In school I remember that they taught us that there are four seasons. Winter, spring, summer and autumn. However, having lived in Potter County for most of my life, I would argue that there actually is a fifth season. I tends to fit in between winter and spring. The grass is brown and soggy. Most cars on the road could use a trip through the carwash. Taking a walk in the woods results in shoes that weigh five pounds each when you get back. Boots and sneakers are lined up on mats right inside front doors. Parents are reminding children to wipe their feet. You know, mud season. The transition time between the dull, dead gray of winter and the vibrant green of spring. I don't enjoy the mess, but I've lived here long enough to know that it doesn't last forever.

Transitions can be messy. Transitions can be dirty. Not just in nature, but in our spiritual lives as well. We've recently finished up a series of sermons on our journey to freedom. One of the main takeaways from that series for me is that even when I am pursuing what God has for me, it might get messy. As I cry out to Him for new life, there just might be a spiritual "mud season" that I have to go through. In fact, it probably going to happen. Much like the Hebrews spent forty years wandering in the desert being transformed from slaves to soldiers, there may be seasons of wandering in my life as God transforms me into the image of Jesus. These seasons of transition are most likely not going to be enjoyable, but they are a necessary part of the process. If I want the warm sunny days of spring, I must endure the brown soggy days of "mud season." I just need to trust the process! Apostle Paul puts it like this in Philippians 1:6 **being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.** If God has begun the transition, He will complete it! It may seem like mud season now, but the end result is new life. I just need to wipe my feet and keep stepping!
